WORLD MISSIONS

Wherever the gospel is preached, no matter how crudely, there are bound to be results.—Billy Graham (b. Nov. 7, 1918), American evangelist who has preached to 215 million people in 184 countries.

THE CHINA PARTNERSHIP

The China Partnership which started out as an organization led by American expatriates serving in 4 cities has developed into an indigenous-led network of churches and ministries that serve more than 100 cities. FPCC partners leading the CP facilitate the work of this network by providing church planting and pastoral training and mentoring. To take the ministry to the next level, our partners will continue to facilitate church planting—plus focus on movement development for gospel-centered church plants and church maturity, resource development and theological training, national leadership, and indigenous financial support development. On February 8, the Chinese government will implement new religious restrictions that could impact the churches who identify with the CP network. “No reserves, no retreats, no regrets!” expresses the sentiment of our CP partners. Please keep Enoch, Peter, Ben, Tim, and David in your prayers as they navigate potential barriers to the ministry.

Note: To date, First Presbyterian World Missions has contributed over \$300,000 in support of the CP leadership team and CP ministry initiatives including funding for the Mandarin seminary curriculum developed by Third Millennium Ministries. This curriculum is the only training accessible to many of the house church pastors who live and serve in Mainland China.
