INTERNATIONAL PARTNERS OF THE WEEK

Scott and Margaret Smith have been serving in Africa since 2001—currently in Equatorial Guinea and previously heading up Wycliffe Spain for 12 years. The couple is involved in translation work among various people groups. Please pray for the Smiths as they: 1) Partner with the Council of Scientific and Technological Research this month to lead a workshop, “Planning the Future of Our Language”—teaching facilitators from four language communities how to develop and promote their languages; 2) Lead the Bible Translation Practicum course this month—working to translate the book of Ruth into the Fang, Kombe, and Basek languages; and 3) Write two articles for a translation consultant growth plan and two articles for sociolinguistic publications. The Smiths offer praise for the checks on the Benga Luke translation and the start on Acts, for Andrew Case who will soon be serving as the Spanish-speaking consultant—moving the work ahead at a faster pace, for opportunities for Scott to present linguistic papers, and for the couple's good health. Note: Margaret Smith is the daughter of FPCC members and former Wycliffe missionaries, Ed and Sally Koehn. Scott and Margaret are the parents of FPCC member, Rachel Laskowske.
