Jay and Maureen Kyle serve with Redeemer City to City which assists and trains indigenous leaders in the world's 50 largest global cities to begin gospel-centered churches. As CTC's Vice President of Asia Pacific and Latin America, Jay's responsibilities include recruiting, mentoring, and coaching church planters in the megacities of Asia and Latin America. Jay will be giving a featured address at the *Center Church Conference* hosted by *City to City Korea* that is taking place March 4-8 in Seoul. The conference is on *gospel, city, and movement* for ministry leaders. Tim Keller will be the keynote speaker. The first evening session is open to the public, and Tim will speak at that time on *suffering*, a core theme for Koreans. Already 2,000 people have registered to attend. Please pray for Jay as he oversees the CTCK team and gives his talk and for Tim Keller as he brings the gospel-centered training. Especially pray that this conference will renew the participants' love for and joy in the gospel so that the gospel would go forward in boldness and confidence in Korea to the glory of God and the blessing of the Korean people.
